Disposition

1. **Defense's request for exclusion of witnesses is GRANTED. All potential witnesses, with the exception of the case agents, are excluded from the courtroom.**
2. **None of the testimony to be elicited from Ms. Weigel is in violation of the prohibitions of 18 USC sec. 3153, and the court finds good cause to do so. The testimony of Pretrial Services Officer Weigel will be heard.**
