21 Defendant AMR MOHSEN, through his attorneys Bruce Locke and John  
22 Balazs, applies for an order that the Dyer Detention Center permit Mr.  
23 Mohsen to receive a conference call from the bankruptcy court on  
24 October 26, 2006, at 2:30 p.m. concerning his pro se personal  
25 bankruptcy action in U.S. Bankruptcy Court, N.D. Cal. No. 05-50662-JRG.  
26 A copy of the bankruptcy court's order setting a telephonic case  
27 management conference call on October 26, 2006, at 2:30 p.m. is  
28 attached as Exhibit 1. The instructions for the call are attached as

1 the last page of the order.

2 In July, 2006, Mr. Mohsen's counsel arranged informally with Dyer  
3 Detention Center staff for Mr. Mohsen to participate in a similar  
4 conference call with the bankruptcy court with respect to this  
5 bankruptcy case. The jail staff provided a number for the bankruptcy  
6 court to call and Mr. Mohsen participated in the Court's conference  
7 call without incident. The staff at the time stated that it would  
8 approve the call on a one time basis, and that it would not approve  
9 future conference calls in the case. As a result, Mr. Mohsen, through  
10 counsel, applies for an order that the Dyer Detention Center permit Mr.  
11 Mohsen to participate in the upcoming bankruptcy conference call in his  
12 pro se action. This would require that the jail staff make Mr. Mohsen  
13 available to receive a call from the bankruptcy court on October 26,  
14 2006. Mr. Mohsen does not have counsel in his bankruptcy matter and  
15 the call is expected to discuss important matters concerning his  
16 bankruptcy case that require Mr. Mohsen's input as a party. The  
17 bankruptcy court's \$40 fee for the conference call will be paid for by  
18 Mr. Mohsen's family. Defense counsel has faxed a copy of this  
19 application and proposed order to the U.S. Marshal's Office on the day  
20 of filing.

2 Defendant is not under any restrictions imposed by this court,  
3 other than those which apply to all other inmates, at the Dyer  
4 Detention Center. The matters which he wishes to discuss in his  
5 telephone call are within the jurisdiction of the Bankruptcy Court, and  
6 are not related to this criminal case. Therefore, defendant's  
7 application for an order authorizing the Dyer Detention Center to allow  
8 him to receive a telephone call from the bankruptcy court in his pro se  
9 personal bankruptcy action is DENIED, without prejudice to defendant's  
10 right to seek appropriate relief from the Bankruptcy Court.
