SUMMARY

- Government's exhibit #1 for sentencing is admitted
- The defendant is sentenced to 204 months in the custody of the BOP: 60 mos. on Counts 1-4, 10, 11-18; 120 mos. on Counts 19 and 21; 144 mos. on Count 20 to be served concurrently and a mandatory term of 60 mos. on Count 22 to be served consecutively. The defendant is to be housed in a facility in California.
- The defendant is on supervised release for a period of 5 years: 5 yrs. on Count 20 and 3 yrs. on each of Counts 1-4 and 10-21 to run concurrently.
- A special assessment of \$1700 is imposed. Fine is waived.
- Restitution in this case is the unpaid balance of the civil judgment – amount to be determined by the parties and probation from the Cadence lawyers.
